

# NEW YORK AQUARIUM ENTRANCE CANOPY

### **Case Study**

#### Background

The New York Aquarium was founded in 1896 and is one of the oldest aquariums in the country. It currently operates on 14 acres in Coney Park, NY. It features several tension and tensile canopy structures, and for almost a decade, Signature Structures has serviced them all, including a dramatic entrance canopy that welcomes visitors to the facility

#### The Challenge
