Background

The Poulsbo Yacht Club, located on Liberty Bay in Northwest Washington State, was founded in 1956. One of the club's features were covered boat slips that protected members yacht's from the damaging effects of sun, rain, and hail. These PVC membrane covers were becoming less reliable with age and needed to be replaced.

While many companies manufacture tension fabric structures for use as weather protection shelters, very few companies stand behind their work either for ongoing maintenance and eventual refurbishment. The club needed to find a company with the experience and expertise to perform the work.

The Result


